You were drawn as <Exhibitor/Alternate #20X> in the VST draw for entries.

Thank you for your entry in Oakland Dog Training Club's Variable Surface Tracking (VST) Test, which will be held at California State University East Bay in Hayward, California, on Sunday, December 31, 2017.

**ENTRIES:** There were six (6) entries received for this test. A random draw was held to determine the exhibitor and alternate list. Dogs #201 through #203 are in the test. Dogs #204 through #206 are alternates. If you would like to withdraw your entry, please do so in writing to the Test Secretary at the email or address below.

**RUNNING ORDER:** Draw for track running order will be held at the test site at **9:15 AM in Parking Lot L**. Entrants not present at the time of the draw will be marked absent, and an alternate will be allowed to run in their place. Judging will begin when tracks have aged sufficiently.

**BITCHES IN SEASON MAY PARTICIPATE** in the test with prior notice to the Test Secretary and in compliance with all provisions of Chapter 2, Section 8 of the AKC Tracking Regulations.

**REFUND POLICY:** The entry fee shall be refunded in the following cases: (1) If the entrant notifies the Test Secretary at least 48 hours prior to the test, and an alternate is available to run the track; or (2) for an entrant or alternate that is not given an opportunity to run a track.

**DIRECTIONS:** California State University East Bay, 25800 Carlos Bee Blvd, Hayward, CA 94542.

**From Oakland Area,** Take Highway 580 Eastbound to Hayward and exit on the Hayward exit. Continue on Foothill Blvd into downtown Hayward. Turn right onto "A" Street, go two blocks, left onto Mission Blvd for several blocks. Turn left onto Carlos Bee Blvd, go up hill, and stay to the far right to enter the campus. At the stop sign, turn left, go one block, turn right and park in **Parking Lot "L"** behind Music-Business Building.

**CSUEB HAYWARD CAMPUS:** Please follow all campus rules, parking policies, and possible fees. The campus typically does not charge for parking on the weekends. Below is a link to a map of campus:

You will likely need to drive to the restrooms, so that you do not walk across any tracks. Since CSUEB is public land, the general public and other dogs may be on campus that day. Please be respectful of the campus facilities and others' use of this location, so that our club may continue to have permission from the University to use this site for our future events.

**PLEASE DO NOT PRACTICE AT THE TEST SITE WITHIN THREE DAYS OF THE TEST, per AKC regulations.**

**MORNING HOSPITALITY** will be provided along with **LUNCHEON** after completion of the test. We invite all exhibitors and spectators to join us. Please bring a folding chair with you, as seating will be limited.

**HEALTH AND SAFETY** of the dogs, exhibitors, judges, and spectators is of paramount importance. The test may be cancelled or stopped before completion in the case of extreme weather conditions such as, but not limited to, lightning, extreme heat, hurricanes, floods, fires, or earthquakes, for the well-being of people and dogs. If you leave your dog in your vehicle, please make sure it is safe and secure. In case of a disaster, we recommend you carry in your vehicle sufficient food, water, and medications for any humans or dogs traveling with you.
