WARM-UP RING

A warm-up ring will be available for exhibitors, starting at 7:30 AM. There is a five minute time limit per dog. Sign-ups will be on a first come, first served basis. Food and toys are allowed but please do not leave food on the ground. NO CORRECTIONS OR INTENSIVE TRAINING are allowed in the warm-up ring or on the trial grounds. The warm-up ring will close at 11:00 AM.

CLASS TRANSFERS (MOVE-UPS) IN OBEDIENCE AND RALLY to next level are allowed for dogs completing a title after close of entries. The request must be made **IN WRITING** to the Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to start of judging.

DIRECTIONS TO TRIAL SITE FROM HWY 880 –

- From Hwy 880 in Hayward, take the Jackson Street exit eastbound. Continue on Jackson into downtown Hayward.
- Turn right onto Mission Blvd and go ½ mile.
- Turn left on Carlos Bee Blvd, go uphill and stay to far right to enter the Cal State campus.
- At stop sign, turn left onto Loop Road.
- At next stop sign, turn right, then right again and park in **LOT K.**
- Access to trial site is via the paved walkway next to the Theater.

DIRECTIONS FROM OAKLAND AREA —

- Take Hwy 580 East to Hayward. Take the Hayward exit, the road becomes Foothill Blvd.
- Continue on Foothill Blvd into downtown Hayward.
- Turn right onto "A Street, two blocks, left onto Mission Blvd for several blocks.
- Turn left on Carlos Bee Blvd, go uphill and stay to far right to enter the Cal State campus.
- At stop sign, turn left onto Loop Road.
- At next stop sign, turn right, then right again and park in **LOT K.**

DIRECTIONS FROM DUBLIN AREA —

- Take Hwy 580 West to Castro Valley. Exit on Redwood Road, turn left.
- Continue on Redwood as it becomes "A" Street in Hayward.
- Cross Foothill Blvd, two blocks, then turn left onto Mission Blvd for several blocks.
- Turn left on Carlos Bee Blvd, go uphill and stay to far right to enter the Cal State campus.
- At stop sign, turn left onto Loop Road.
- At next stop sign, turn right, then right again, and park in **LOT K.**

There is no charge for parking on weekends.

NO DRIVING ONTO THE GROUNDS IS ALLOWED. PLEASE BE PREPARED TO HAUL YOUR EQUIPMENT FROM THE PARKING LOT. LIMITED SHADE IS AVAILABLE. Please bring canopies to shade your dogs and yourselves. Please do not set up in roped-off areas. Complimentary catalogs will be available at the Trial Secretary's table at the show. **ARMBANDS** will be at the rings. No food is available for sale on the grounds.

BITCHES IN SEASON are not permitted to compete. If a female is withdrawn from competition for coming into season and the Trial Secretary is notified no later than ½ hour prior to the start of the first class, then the club will refund the entry fee. **A processing fee of \$10.00 per entry will be retained.** A signed veterinarian's letter stating the bitch is in season must be provided as documentation with the request or within one week of the trial at the latest to receive a refund.
