- Entries will receive an immediate validation via email. This will not be confirmation of entry in the trial. Ten days after opening, entries will receive an email stating either confirmation into the trial or placed on the waitlist.
- Entries remaining on the waitlist after trial close date will have the entire entry fee refunded within 2 weeks of trial close.
- **No mailed or hand delivered entries will be accepted.**

#### **ENTRIES CLOSE Wednesday, November 25, 2020 8:00 AM**

at the address of the Trial Secretary, after which time entries cannot be accepted, cancelled, or changed, except for as provided in Chapter 1, Section 16 of the AKC Obedience Regulations.

#### **Rules for entering this trial:**

1. DO NOT COME IF YOU FEEL SICK. (If the club is able to fill your entries from the wait list, your entry fees will be refunded.)
2. DO NOT COME if you have traveled out of the state and have not sheltered in place for 14 days!
3. DO NOT COME if you have been to any large gatherings within the 14 days prior to this trial! This rule does not apply to attendance at local matches or trials.

### **Grounds rules:**

1. NO overnight & NO day of RV parking.
2. NO smoking allowed on the grounds.
3. There will be a door monitor. You may not enter the building on your own.
4. Once you exit the ring you will need to exit the building.
5. You will not be allowed to watch from inside the building.
6. Check-in will be done outside the building.
7. Crating – there will be NO crating in the building. You will be required to crate from your vehicle or the enclosed courtyard. Bring canopies and/or shade cloth. Please keep dogs quiet. If barking cannot be controlled you will be asked to leave. Keep dogs on leash while not working.
8. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Dog exercise areas will be described in the Judging Program

### **Covid 19 – best practices:**

1. Participants are required to follow state, local, and facility guidelines that are in effect at the time of the event.
2. You will be required to wear a mask (face covering) while in the building, parking area next to building and courtyard. You may not enter the building if you are not wearing a mask, which means you will be required to wear a mask in the ring while competing with your dog. You must bring your own mask!
3. For parking – 17 spaces are next to building and 21 spaces are directly across ward street. Street parking free.
4. Practice social distancing consistent with current guidelines. Avoid congregating to the extent possible.
5. Wear masks when in close proximity to others.
6. If you utilize the portable toilet, clean your hands before and after you enter.
7. Avoid shaking hands or hugging.
8. Avoid touching dogs that are not your responsibility.
9. Avoid common use of pens/pencils – bring your own.

## ADDITIONAL TRIAL RULES

- 1 HOW TO ENTER:
  - ONLINE - Use TRIALENTRIES.COM . Follow directions, entering data accurately, including form of payment information.
- 2 **No Mailed or hand delivered entries will be accepted.**
- 3 The club assumes no responsibility for a wrong entry.
- 4 Entries specifying any condition as to acceptance cannot be accepted. Unsigned, incomplete, telephone, fax, mailed, hand delivered, or email entries will not be accepted.
- 5 The owner is responsible for errors on entry forms, for entering the same dog twice, or for entering a dog in a class in which it is ineligible to compete, regardless of who makes such errors. No dog wrongly entered in a class may be transferred to another class after close of entries. Changes, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to close of entries. Changes by telephone are not acceptable.
- 6 **ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF RECEIPT:**
  - Entries will receive an immediate validation via email. This will not be confirmation of entry in the trial. Ten days after opening, entries will receive an email stating either confirmation into the trial or placed on the waitlist. Entries remaining on the waitlist after trial close date will have the entire entry fee refunded within 2 weeks of trial close.
- 7 If acknowledgments are not received by an exhibitor 7 days prior to the Trial, please notify the Trial Secretary.
- 8 Consult Judging Schedule for time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging may be excused after their class has been judged. We suggest dogs be present one hour before scheduled time of judging.
- 9 Exhibitors and handlers alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring. The Club and the Trial Secretary assume no responsibility in this regard.
- 10 The Club will exercise every precaution for the safety of dogs exhibited, but it must be understood that the Club will not be responsible for loss or injury.
- 11 Dogs must be kept on leash except when in the judging ring.
- 12 There shall be no drilling, intensive or corrective training of dogs on Trial grounds or premises.
- 13 In case of a tie for any prizes, any dog that is not present for a run-off forfeits the right to the prize.
- 14 Entry fees will not be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, loss of site, or other acts beyond the control of the Club, or if it is impossible to open or to complete the Trial, no refund of entry fees will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat or earthquakes, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors, and spectators. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the Trial before completion, no refund of entry fees will be made.
- 15 MOVE-UPS (Class Transfers) will not be permitted.
- 16 BITCHES IN SEASON are not permitted to compete. If a female is withdrawn from competition for coming into season and the Trial Secretary is notified no later than ½ hour prior to the start of the first class, then the Club will refund the entry fee. A processing fee of \$10.00 per entry will be retained. A signed veterinarian's letter stating the bitch is in season must be provided as documentation with the request or within one week of the trial, at the latest, to receive a refund.

#### **AGREEMENT**

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. **I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN ITS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. HOWEVER, PRIOR TO ARBITRATION ALL APPLICABLE AKC BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES MUST FIRST BE FOLLOWED AS SET FORTH IN THE AKC CHARTER AND BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS, PUBLISHED POLICIES AND GUIDELINES.**

#### **INSTRUCTIONS**

1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.

**AGREEMENT**  
**Risk and Waiver of Liability Relating to Coronavirus/COVID-19**  
**Oakland Dog Training Club**

For the purpose of this agreement, the term "ODTC Event" shall include, but not be limited to, my attendance, participation, activity, or presence in or at any Oakland Dog Training Club (hereinafter referred to as "ODTC") sponsored dog training classes, the ODTC training hall, and any ODTC sponsored events including but not limited to member matches and obedience trials. By entering this event, I acknowledge the contagious nature of COVID-19 and voluntarily assume the risk that I may be exposed to or infected by COVID-19 at an ODTC Event, and that such exposure or infection may result in personal injury, illness, permanent disability, and death. I understand that the risk of becoming exposed to or infected by COVID-19 at an ODTC Event may result from the actions, omissions, or negligence of myself and others, including, but not limited to, ODTC Officers, Board members, employees, trainers, members, committee members, volunteers, land owners, and program participants and their families. I voluntarily agree to assume all of the foregoing risks and accept sole responsibility for any injury to myself (including, but not limited to, personal injury, disability, and death), illness, damage, loss, claim, liability, or expense, of any kind, that I may experience or incur in connection with my attendance at an ODTC Event. On my behalf, I hereby release, covenant not to sue, discharge, and hold harmless the ODTC, its Officers, Board members, employees, trainers, members, committee members, grounds owners, agents, and representatives, of and from the Claims, including all liabilities, claims, actions, damages, costs or expenses of any kind arising out of or relating thereto. I understand and agree that this release includes any Claims based on the actions, omissions, or negligence of the ODTC officers, Board members, employees, trainers, members, committee members, volunteers, land owners, agents, and representatives, whether a COVID-19 infection occurs before, during, or after participation in any ODTC Event.
