**Grounds rules:**

- 1.NO overnight & NO day of RV parking.**
- 2.NO smoking allowed on the grounds.**
- 3.There will be a door monitor. You may not enter the building on your own.**
- 4.Once you exit the ring you will need to exit the building.**
- 5.You will not be allowed to watch from inside the building.**
- 6.Check - in will be done outside the building.**
- 7.Crating – there will be NO crating in the building. You will be required to crate from your vehicle. Bring canopies and/or shade cloth. Please keep dogs quiet, if barking cannot be controlled you will be asked to leave. Keep dogs on leash while not working.**
- 8.Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations near the show grounds as described later.**

**Covid 19 – best practices:**

- 1.Participants are required to follow state, local, and facility guidelines that are in effect at the time of the event.**
- 2.You will be required to wear a mask (face covering) while in the building, parking area next to building and courtyard. You may not enter the building if you are not wearing a mask, which means you will be required to wear a mask in the ring while competing with your dog. You must bring your own mask!**
- 3.For parking – 17 spaces are next to building and 21 spaces are directly across ward street. Street parking free.**
- 4.Practice social distancing consistent with current guidelines. Avoid congregating to the extent possible.**
- 5.Wear masks when in close proximity to others.**
- 6.If you utilize the portable toilet, clean your hands before and after you enter.**
- 7.Avoid shaking hands or hugging.**
- 8.Avoid touching dogs that are not your responsibility.**
- 9.Avoid common use of pens/pencils – bring your own.**

## Remembering Noelle Pilat – by Sue Harvey

As many members know, Noelle was a long-time member of ODTC until she moved to Acampo a few years ago. Noelle passed away suddenly in early January. Here are some notes about her as remembered by her long-time friend Sue Harvey.

Noelle grew up in the Oakland Hills in a family with horses on their property. As a young adult she rode in and completed the very difficult Rubicon Trail Endurance Ride. She continued her love of horses and riding throughout her life.

In the early 1980s she bought her first Doberman, started obedience training her, and joined ODTC in 1983. From 1986 through 1999 she was on the club board of directors, serving as secretary, treasurer, trial secretary (twice), and president along with several years as director. She also put in a year as the trainer when we found ourselves suddenly without one. When a new trainer was hired, Noelle happily retired from training for the club.

## ADDITIONAL TRIAL RULES

- 1 HOW TO ENTER: ONLINE @ TRIALENTRIES.COM. Follow directions, entering data accurately, including form of payment information. No mailed or hand delivered entries allowed.
- 2 The club assumes no responsibility for a wrong entry.
- 3 Entries without fees cannot be accepted. Entries specifying any condition as to acceptance cannot be accepted.
- 4 The owner is responsible for errors on entry forms, for entering the same dog twice, or for entering a dog in a class in which it is ineligible to compete, regardless of who makes such errors. No dog wrongly entered in a class may be transferred to another class after close of entries. Changes, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to close of entries. Changes by telephone are not acceptable.
- 5 ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF RECEIPT:  
Entries will receive an immediate validation via email. This will not be confirmation of entry in the trial. After closing, all entries will receive an email giving their armband numbers or notification their entry was not accepted.
- 6 If acknowledgments are not received by an exhibitor 7 days prior to the Trial, please notify the Trial Secretary.
- 7 Consult Judging Schedule for time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging may be excused after their class has been judged. We suggest dogs be present one hour before scheduled time of judging.
- 8 Exhibitors and handlers alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring. The Club and the Trial Secretary assume no responsibility in this regard.
- 9 The Club will exercise every precaution for the safety of dogs exhibited, but it must be understood that the Club will not be responsible for loss or injury.
- 10 Dogs must be kept on leash except when in the judging ring.
- 11 There shall be no drilling, intensive or corrective training of dogs on Trial grounds or premises.
- 12 In case of a tie for any prizes, any dog that is not present for a run-off forfeits the right to the prize.
- 13 Entry fees will not be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, loss of site, or other acts beyond the control of the Club, or if it is impossible to open or to complete the Trial, no refund of entry fees will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat or earthquakes, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors, and spectators. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the Trial before completion, no refund of entry fees will be made.
- 14 BITCHES IN SEASON are not permitted to compete. If a female is withdrawn from competition for coming into season and the Trial Secretary is notified no later than ½ hour prior to the start of the first class, then the Club will refund the entry fee. A processing fee of \$10.00 per entry will be retained. A signed veterinarian's letter stating the bitch is in season must be provided as documentation with the request or within one week of the trial, at the latest, to receive a refund.
