

Class Training Hall Protocols



Crating dogs in the hall is not allowed at this time.

Face coverings must be worn at all times when working at ODTTC. This applies to students and instructors.

Face coverings must be worn in the building even if you are alone.

Face coverings must be worn when utilizing other public access areas in the industrial park.

Consolidate gear into a single tote/bag/plastic container to minimize handled objects during training.

Handler/dog teams are to enter and exit the hall one at a time as directed by the instructor. Please move away from the hall door after exiting the hall.

Use provided sanitizer when entering and exiting the building.

Maintain 6' distance from one another in the building, when entering and exiting, and as much as possible outside.

Stay in your assigned location (usually a chair) unless otherwise directed by the instructor. Only one person per dog is allowed at the hall during training.

If you are asked to handle club equipment by the instructor, sanitize hands before and after use, or use and dispose of the disposable gloves provided by the instructor.

Equipment cordoned/sheeted off is not to be used by students.
